Jefferson County Honored by UnitedHealthcare for Creating a Culture of Wellness

- *Jefferson County receives “Golden Apple” recognition for earning the distinction as a Well-Deserved organization twice*

DENVER (August 4, 2017) – UnitedHealthcare recognized Jefferson County for implementing a successful workplace wellness program to improve its employees’ health and well-being.

Jefferson County was one of 10 organizations across the United States awarded with a UnitedHealthcare “Well Deserved” award for its year-long wellness program that produced a culture of wellness in the workplace. Jefferson County also received this year’s “Golden Apple” award for earning this distinction from UnitedHealthcare twice.

The award will be presented at the Board of Jefferson County Commissioners Hearing in Golden at 8 a.m. Tuesday, Aug. 8.

Jefferson County distinguished itself by creating an innovative wellness program that incorporated 40+ Wellness Champions from across the enterprise and within its many diverse departments. These Champions tailored messages that fit the unique culture of the offices in which they work. The program is supported by senior leadership who are also Wellness Champions, participating and encouraging employee participation in activities such as farmer’s markets, a Door-to-Door Organics Co-Op, meditation and stress-reduction classes, and healthy-cooking classes. Also, standing desks are widely used among employees, and this year Jefferson County is piloting a Treadmill Desk Pilot Program.

“Jefferson County has set a great example of how companies can support their employees’ desire to improve their health,” said Beth Soberg, CEO of UnitedHealthcare of Colorado and Wyoming. “Most employees with access to wellness programs say they make a positive impact on their health, and employers may benefit as well from increased employee satisfaction, lower absenteeism, increased productivity and lower medical costs.”

“Our employees love the wellness program,” said Jefferson County Commissioner and Board Chair Libby Szabo. “From online challenges to educational seminars and beyond, the feedback we receive is overwhelmingly positive.

“In addition to this honor from UnitedHealthcare, this year Jefferson County was selected as a Health Links Certified Healthy Business Leader and a Top 5 finalist for the Colorado Governor’s Award for worksite wellness. We are thrilled to be able to support our employees in this way,” said Szabo.
